Škoda vehicles meet recyclability requirements

Škoda vehicles have met the legislated new recyclability requirements earlier than required. All the current models already meet the EU Directive 2005/64/EC.

The Ministry of Transport of the Czech Republic has issued **recyclability certificates for Fabia, Roomster, Octavia and Superb** vehicles. As a result, Škoda Auto has met the legislated new vehicle recyclability requirements earlier than required – the obligation to prove compliance with the said requirements shall **enter into force on 15 July, 2010**.

Škoda vehicles are made of recyclable and environmentally-friendly materials. All of the currently produced Škoda models are already certified under the **EU Directive 2005/64/EC** stipulating that 85% of the vehicle's weight has to be recyclable, i.e., most of the applied materials have to be recycled.

Škoda Auto is committed to **environmental protection** in all stages of the product life cycle, i.e., development, manufacturing, product use, as well as environmentally-friendly disposal.
